



# Quick Start Guide: Integrate Your SuperControl Account with Beyond Pricing

#### **Before You Start**

Make sure your properties have Blue Price Bands (even if they're newly added).

Set up Green Short Break Bands in SuperControl to define your preferred lengths of stay for short breaks.

# **Step-by-Step Integration**

### 1. Enable Beyond Pricing Integration





• Click **enable** next to each property you'd like to link with Beyond Pricing. (Note: This will save a snapshot of your current prices in case you want to revert back.)

#### 2. Get Started with Beyond

- Click on more information and get started (you'll find this on the Beyond Pricing integration page).
- You'll be directed to Beyond's website.

## 3. Copy Your Activation Key

- Copy the activation key found on the Beyond Pricing Integration page in SuperControl.
- Go to Beyond's website and paste the key when prompted.

#### 4. Complete Beyond Setup

 Follow the steps provided in Beyond's setup instructions to finish configuring your account. Beyond will then automatically manage your prices, updating them every 24 hours based on market data.

#### **Good to Know**

**Channel Pricing:** If you already sync prices to Airbnb or <u>Booking.com</u> through SuperControl, no additional setup is needed—Beyond Pricing will update SuperControl, and SuperControl will push those rates to your channels.

**Short Break Pricing Options:** By default, Beyond calculates short break prices as the **sum of nightly rates**.

Alternatively, you can set short break prices as a **fixed percentage of your weekly rate**. Simply enable this on the Beyond Pricing page in SuperControl and adjust the percentage if needed.
